
#### **Fundraising Concerts**

#### **Lost Property**

The lost property is building up again! Please come and look for lost items in the boxes outside the office. Now that the weather is getting warmer, children tend to take off fleeces, jumpers and cardigans and leave them lying around. As they all look the same it is hard to return them to their owners if they are unnamed. Please name your child's belongings, this can be easily done by just writing on the label, but please check that the name is still visible each time the items are washed.

#### **Parking**

Our road closure zone is intended to keep our children safer at drop off and pick up time. This only works if everyone parks their cars in designated parking bays outside the closure zone. If you park across the barriers, on pavements or on double yellow lines you are putting our children at risk. The area directly around the school gets very busy, particularly at pick up time so please try to arrive a few minutes early so that you can park further away and walk to school, avoiding getting stuck in the pick-up time congestion.
