

Year One Celebration Days

Workshops

It has been great to see so many parents coming to our workshops to find out more about how children learn in school. Maths workshops for Years 3 and 4 and Reception are coming up in the next two weeks, please come along.

Jewellery

Children should not be wearing any jewellery (other than stud or small sleeper earrings) to school unless it is essential for religious reasons. This is because jewellery can get caught or pulled while children are playing which can be dangerous to children or can damage the jewelry. Children cannot take part in PE while wearing jewellery and items are often lost when removed for PE, so please leave all jewellery at home.

Naming Uniform

Please ensure that everything that your child brings to school is named. This can be as simple as writing their name on a label in biro. During the winter months children often take off jumpers, coats, hats and gloves when playing and if they are not named they often end up in the lost property box unclaimed. Named items are always returned to their owners.

Sharing Children's Learning

Connected to the Community

One of Bessemer's core values is *Connected to the Community* and one way in which we reflect this value is in our support of our local foodbank, The Community Fridge, based at Albrighton Community Centre. The Children who make up our school council spent Tuesday morning at the community centre this week, helping to sort our harvest festival donations for The Community Fridge, which aims to reduce food waste and supports an average of 350 households per week. A huge thank you to everyone who contributed to our harvest collection.
