World Book Day on Thursday, March 7th!


Reminder of competitions:

We have already received some entries for both competitions but have now decided to extend the deadline for both KS1 and KS2.



This week some children from Years 3 and 4 attended a festival of sport at Keyworth. Everyone had a great time and demonstrated brilliant teamwork.














All classes across the school have continued to enjoy their library visits this term. Here are some children from Reception exploring the library this week:

The clues for next week's word:


Where to find it – Find me under 'i' (adjective).
