Inclusion Coffee Morning

We held our first inclusion coffee morning in school this week, unfortunately the turn out was very disappointing. We planned the coffee morning because we are aware that many parents have questions or uncertainties about elements of our provision and we wanted to provide a forum to discuss these issues with members of the inclusion team and senior leadership team who are able to provide answers and clarity. The parents who did attend this week found the session helpful and thought that continuing to hold these events was a good idea.

We are going to hold another coffee morning later this term and we strongly urge you to come along if there is anything at all that you are unsure of regarding inclusion. It is an informal, drop in session, you don't have to stay long, just pop in for a coffee and have your questions answered. We will share the next date in next week's newsletter.

Hot Weather

While the weather is very hot, please ensure that your child has a full water bottle in school every day (these can be refilled in school during the day) and that they wear sun cream and bring a hat.

Please could you also make sure that your child is not wearing layers in this weather as the school building can get very warm. We do have fans in the classrooms but when the temperature reaches 30 degrees as it has this week we also allow children to bring hand held fans to school. However, the use of these fans is at the teachers' discretion and children may be asked not to use them at times if they are causing disruption.

Year 6 Residential Trip

The Year 6 children went on their residential trip this week, spending two nights away at an activity centre in Mersea. They took part in activities such as zip lining, climbing, pioneering, orienteering, archery, kit cars and the giant swing. Everyone had a great time and came back hot and tired but happy!





