News and Reminders

Harvest Collection

One of our core values at Bessemer is *Connected to the Community*. It is really important to us to play an active role in our local community; as well as having our amazing Bessemer community around us, we benefit from support and resources in our wider community too, for example volunteer readers from local secondary schools, visits from community police officers and local library trips to name but a few. In return, we try hard to support our community. At the moment we are celebrating Harvest Festival by collecting food for our local foodbank. On Tuesday 31st October our school council children will be going to the food bank to help to sort the donations. While the deadline for donating items was today, we will continue to accept donations on Monday 30th October as we would like to have as much as possible to take with us. TimesTable Rockstars

A few minutes a day on Timestable Rockstars is a great way for children to improve their recall of multiplication and division facts, which will develop their confidence and ability in many areas of maths. Please see the attached poster for details of a Timestable Rockstars competition and encourage your child to take part over half term.

Spellings

We have been asked for clarification around the changes to our teaching of spellings. The reason for the change in approach is that we did not feel our teaching of spelling was as effective as teaching in other areas and we wanted to improve results. We have started to use *Pathways to Spelling* which includes lots of fun and creative ways to teach spelling patterns. Spelling lessons are taught three times a week from Year 2, when children are secure in phonics. The spelling words being taught in the lessons are sent home each week and we encourage children to practise them during the week. There is then a collaborative 'test' in Friday's lesson, during which children work together to remember the spelling patterns and spell the words correctly. While children are no longer tested individually on spellings we do encourage children to do their best to learn them. The collaborative test is beneficial as children learn from each other while discussing spelling rules and it is more supportive for children than an individual test. So far everyone is really enjoying the new approach.

Autism Spectrum Condition (ASC) Parent Group














Word of the Week
