The theme was 'All Around the World' where both the classrooms and the outdoor areas was dedicated to a country setup with fun activities.

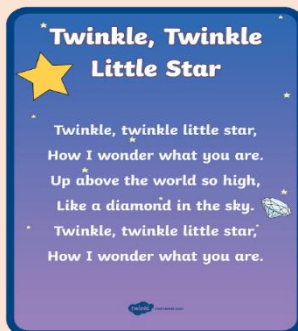
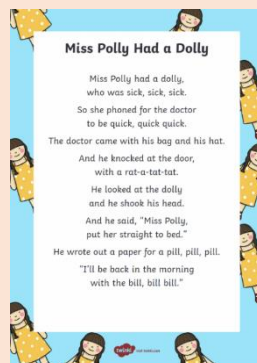
We celebrated many countries including; India, Ghana, Jamaica, Norway, Bolivia and Germany.
