And only three little ducks came back!

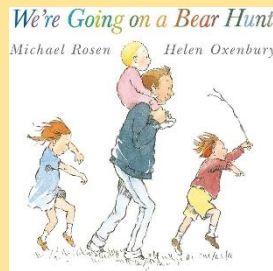
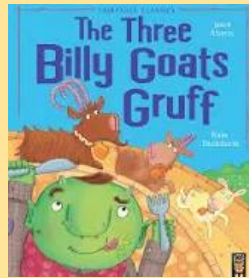
Three little ducks went swimming one day
