### **News and Reminders**

#### **Early Years Forest School Sessions**

Children in Little Stars, Nursery and Reception have weekly Forest School sessions in the nature garden, provided by The Jolly Foresters. These sessions are one of the highlights of the week, with children experiencing a range of exciting activities such as building fires and toasting marshmallows, whittling, sawing wood, hammering nails, water play, crafts, building dens and climbing trees. These activities encourage children to challenge themselves and take risks in a safe environment and support children in developing the resilience they need to become confident learners in other areas.

This fantastic Forest School provision costs £10 000 for the year's sessions – approximately £80 per child. Until now, these sessions have been largely funded by the generous donations of Early Years parents, however this year there is a very significant shortfall, no doubt due to the current financial climate. Unfortunately, pressure on the school's budget means that without these donations we will be unable to continue with our Forest School provision. 


















### Thank You!
