Parking Outside School

We have received a number of complaints from our neighbours about parking outside school at drop off and pick up time. Southwark parking officers have been attending at pick up time and parking tickets have been issued. Parking on double yellow lines, on pavements or across the barriers creates dangerous situations for our children by forcing them to walk in the road, stopping them from seeing whether it is safe to cross the road and causing cars to reverse or manoeuvre unexpectedly. Please help us to keep our children safe by only parking in allocated parking spaces.
