Sports Day

We will be having a picnic lunch on the field so would love it if as many of you as possible could stay for that and bring a picnic to enjoy with your child. Refugee Week

Next week is Refugee Week, so as well as thinking about refugees during assemblies we are inviting children to wear their own clothes to school on Friday and if possible to donate to charities supporting refugees. We will be collecting money on the gates and at the breakfast club door.

Attendance

Our school target for attendance is 96%. In order for a child to achieve 96% attendance for the year they need to have fewer than 10 days of absence over the whole year (this includes authorised and unauthorised absence). The reason that we have attendance targets is that attendance is directly related to attainment. We see very clearly that children with poor attendance fall behind their peers academically.

Every week in assembly we announce which class has the best attendance for the week. This is the attendance for each class from Years 1-6 for Monday-Thursday this week, well done 4KL!

We have updated our attendance policy in line with Southwark's and uploaded the new policy to our website. The new policy states that the school can issue penalty charge notices for unauthorised absences from school in some circumstances.

The attendance policy also sets out the exceptional circumstances in which the school can authorise term time absence. There are very limited reasons for absence that can be authorised by the school so please be aware that requests for holidays in term time cannot be authorised and are likely to lead to a penalty charge being issued. Requests for absence, even in exceptional circumstances, can usually only be authorised if a child's attendance is above target.
