#### News and Reminders

#### **Industrial Action**

As we explained when we wrote to you earlier this week, members of the NEU trade union are taking strike action on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April and Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May. This industrial action is taking place because no agreement on pay has been reached between the government and the NEU. The pay rise that teachers have been offered did not meet the level requested and did not come with an offer of additional funding for schools, meaning that pay rises would come from schools' existing and already overstretched budgets. It is for this reason that NEU members rejected the offer presented.

After careful consideration we have decided that we are unable to keep Bessemer open during the teachers' strikes while maintaining a safe environment for pupils and safe and reasonable working conditions for remaining staff. However, the wellbeing and education of our children is at the heart of everything that we do at Bessemer and our teachers do not take any action which could affect this lightly. As this strike action falls just before the Year 6 SATs it has been decided that on this occasion Year 6 will remain open on the strike days to ensure that the strike action does not cause additional worry to Year 6 children or their families or affect their performance in their SATs, which we know they have worked so hard for. Little Stars will also remain open as usual on the strike days.

After School Club will remain open on the strike days and is available for booking on Parentmail until Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April. School packed lunches can also be ordered for the strike days, they must be ordered on Parentmail by Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April and can then be collected from the office between 12 and 1pm on the days of the strikes. We would all like to take this opportunity to thank parents and carers for the overwhelming positivity that has been felt during the strike action, we are very grateful for all of your messages of support and understanding.

#### **After School Activity Clubs**

There are still some places available in some of our after-school activity clubs. Booking on Parentmail is now closed, but if you would like to book a club please call the school office where staff will be able to make the booking for you. If your child is entitled to pupil premium and you would like to ask about reduced price places (plus a limited number of free places) in activity clubs please speak to a member of the office staff. Activity Clubs scheduled on strike days will be rescheduled for the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> July.

#### **School Lunches Update**

In response to feedback from children and parents we have been working with our catering company to address concerns and have made a number of changes. One recurring issue was that pizza portions were not big enough, so in response to this, from this term pizza slices are now being served with potato wedges as a side, along with the usual vegetable, salad and bread options.

#### Snacks

Please remember that children in KS2 are only allowed to bring fruit, vegetables, plain rice cakes or plain breadsticks for their morning snacks. We know that there are other, equally healthy snacks, but the reason for this limitation is ensuring that teachers do not need to spend teaching time assessing whether individual snacks are healthy options or not.
