News and Reminders

Medication

If your child has any medication in school this must be handed in to the school office, even if it will then be stored in class, e.g. asthma pumps. This is so that the office can keep a record of all medication in school and monitor expiry dates. Children must not be sent to school with medication of any sort, e.g. hay fever tablets or painkillers, in their bags.

Year Two Transition

Every year we find that the transition from Year Two to Year Three is a bit more challenging for our children than the other class transitions they go through during their time with us. We have taken a number of actions to support this transition, such as the introduction of an afternoon play time in Year Three and the implementation of wellbeing strategies in class. This year we are introducing a new strategy to soften the transition for the children. One of the major differences in Year Three is that children are dropped off at the playground gate rather than at their classroom door. Therefore, in the second week back after half term we will be asking Year Two parents and carers to bring children to the Key Stage One playground in the morning, where they will line up with their class and be collected by their teachers. For the first two weeks parents and carers will be able to come in to the playground and wait with their children if they would like to. We will then transition to dropping children off at the gate, as will happen in Year Three. We feel that this change will be much easier for the children to cope with in their current class with their known adults rather than introducing it at the beginning of Year Three when there are so many new things to get used to. Children should come into the playground through the red gate and the playground will be open from 8.50am. All children should be in the playground when the bell goes at 9am.

At home time children will still be collected from their classroom doors so you will still have the opportunity to speak to their class adults on a daily basis if needed.

Free School Meal Provision During the Holiday

Southwark have changed their decision about providing food vouchers over the holiday for children entitled to free school meals, here is their message:

'the decision to end the funding of FSM over the school holidays has been reversed! This is good news indeed and means that support for our vulnerable children and families will continue during the next two holiday periods (May half term and the summer), when the rising cost of living is making a very significant impact and is forcing some very difficult spending decisions.'

Vouchers will be sent out as usual to those families who are entitled to them.


Word of the Week
