Industrial Action

Therapeutic Support

We have been very privileged over the last few years to have been in a position to provide therapeutic support for children within the Gem Federation. We currently have Xavia Sommerville, a psychotherapist, who works with a number of children from Bessemer and Keyworth delivering psychotherapy sessions. Sadly, Xavia will be leaving the federation at half term to continue her career development and the current financial situation means that, very sadly, we are unable to recruit another therapist. We will continue to deliver ELSA sessions in school for children in need of emotional support and will also be able to signpost families towards external support if needed. We are very sorry to be losing Xavia and wish her all the best in her future career.

NSPCC Number Day

On Friday 3rd February it is NSPCC Number Day. Children will take part in fun maths activities and are invited to dress up in clothes which have number on them or relate to numbers, e.g. clothing with spots that can be counted. We have been thinking of ways in which children can make Number Day costumes, e.g. by adding cut out numbers or stickers to a t-shirt. We will be collecting donations for the NSPCC on the gates in the morning.

Mental Health Week

Monday 6th February – Friday 10th February is Mental Health Week. In school we will be focusing on wellbeing and looking after our mental health and children will take part in wellbeing activities during the week. Water Bottles

Please make sure that your child's water bottle is made of plastic or metal, glass water bottles are not allowed in school for health and safety reasons. Water bottles must only contain water, not juice, and should be clearly named.

Parking

We have received more complaints from our neighbours and from school parents and carers about parking outside school at pick up time. Please do not park on the pavements, across the barriers or on the yellow lines as this creates dangerous conditions for children and their families. If you need to drive to school at drop off or pick up time, please try to park on roads further away from school to avoid creating congestion outside the school gates. Our neighbours have contacted the council about the situation, attaching photographs of illegally parked cars, so there is a risk that you will receive a parking ticket if you are not parked in an allocated bay. Please also ensure that you turn off your car engine when dropping off and picking up children as allowing your engine to idle creates unnecessary air pollution.

They attended an educational workshop, where they learnt about the various forms and stages of farming.
