If they do not then bring lunch on the day of the trip it is possible that your child will not be able to attend their trip as no lunch will have been made and they will need to stay at school and have a hot school lunch. Until now we have made school packed lunches if no lunch option has been chosen, but this results in an unacceptable level of food waste so we can not continue to do this.

Year 4 teachers need pieces of clean fabric for their art workshop which is taking place on Monday. If you have any old sheets, towels etc, please take them to the office.


