News and Reminders

Change to Head Injury Procedures

From next week, if your child sustains a non-serious, accidental head bump in school we will send you a text message rather than calling you. The purpose of the message is to make you aware that the accident has happened in the very unlikely event that complications such as concussion develop. If your child's head bump is more serious and we think there is even a small possibility of concussion developing we will call to speak to you directly. If we are unable to contact you we will either leave a message or send a text. We will also contact you by phone rather than text if the injury occurred in a way that requires a more detailed explanation than a simple playground fall or bump. Your child will still have an accident slip to bring home with them whether you receive a call or a text message.

School Uniform and P.E. Kit

We still have a number of children who are not wearing correct school uniform or P.E. kit. School uniform consists of navy trousers, skirt, tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts with a white polo t-shirt or shirt and either a Bessemer jumper, cardigan or fleece or a plain red generic school uniform jumper or cardigan. In summer uniform also includes a red and white checked summer dress.

Now that children wear P.E. kit to school on their P.E. days, we want P.E. kit to be as close to school uniform as possible. P.E. kit should consist of navy tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts with a white polo t-shirt or a Bessemer house t-shirt and a school uniform jumper or cardigan (which will be removed during the lesson unless it is very cold). Trainers must be worn on P.E. days. Children should not be wearing tracksuit tops, hoodies, patterned leggings or tracksuits, sports strips, any items with pictures or writing on or clothing in house colours except for Bessemer logo house t-shirts.

Navy school uniform trousers and skirts can be purchased in most supermarkets and high street shops which sell uniform, however if you are unable to get navy, plain black or grey school uniform items are acceptable. Wearing the correct uniform is a reflection of the high expectations and standards that we hold at Bessemer. We will now be sending reminder emails to parents and carers of children who are not wearing the correct uniform or P.E. kit.
