School Trips

This week children in Year 5 went on a trip to The London Eye after reading The London Eye Mystery in English. It was fantastic to bring the book to life, and a perfect day to admire the views. Everyone had a great time!



Year 1's Trip to The Horniman Museum, a message from Ms Matheson:

On Monday Year 1 went to the Horniman Museum as part of their study of the 'Polar Regions.' We participated in a workshop run by Lucy and had to get into our imaginary aeroplane to fly all the way to the Arctic. We discussed what animals we might find there and learnt about the life of the Inuit people, and how they survived in the past compared to what they have access to now. We found out that Inuit's use animal skins to make their clothing because it is warm and can be waterproof. We saw some toys that the children used including little hand-made dolls, boots that the Inuit people had made and also tools that they have made to help them catch their food. We pretended to go inside an igloo, and found out that they had to use a dish to light a fire using animal fat and two stones to start a spark.

We also had a look around the aquarium. We enjoyed reading the information about the animals on the boards and showed great excitement when we managed to find them in their tanks. They can be a bit sneaky and camouflage or hide under rocks and in or behind coral.

A big thank you to all of our parent helpers. We had a fantastic time on our first trip out since we started school!
