Policies

Mathletics, Reading Eggs and Timestable Rockstars

Unfortunately we no longer have school subscriptions to Mathletics or Reading Eggs; these subscriptions cost £7000 and due to our limited budget we have had to prioritise other subscriptions which we feel are more in line with our curriculum and home learning requirements.

We encourage families to use Timestable Rockstars at home which is great for developing fast recall of multiplication and division facts, an essential skill for developing confidence in maths. There are no Timestable Rockstars winners at Bessemer this week due to the limited number of children who have used it recently, so let's try to change that next week and see if we can move Bessemer up the local area leaderboard! We hope that all children are using their school reading scheme books or free reading books from the class book corners to practice reading at home every day, however for anyone really missing Reading Eggs there are lots of online reading activities available on BBC Bitesize.

Punctuality

The school gates open at the following times every morning:

Key Stage 2 – 8.45am

Key stage 1 - 8.50am

Early Years - 8.55am

The opening times are staggered so that you can drop siblings off on time in different key stages and all children are either in their line in the playground or in their classroom by 9am. All gates are then closed by 9.05am. for Early Years and Key Stage 1 parents and carers this means that you need to have finished dropping your child off and have left school by then. Please ensure that your child is in school on time every morning. While we understand that occasionally, unforeseen circumstances can make you late and this is unavoidable, children arriving after the gates have closed means that adults are called away from teaching to let them in, which disrupts the learning of other children.

Lost Property

Our lost property boxes are overflowing again! When we find items which are named we ensure they are returned to their owners. Any unnamed items are usually only stored in the lost property boxes outside the office for a week before being disposed of. We have not disposed of any lost property since the Easter holiday due to the shortened weeks, so if your child has lost anything please come and have a look before the boxes are cleared out at the end of next week.

Packed Lunches

As a school with a gold Healthy Schools award it is very important to us to encourage healthy eating. Children are not allowed crisps, chocolate bars, cake, sweets or drinks other than water in their daily packed lunches and they will not be allowed to eat these items in school.

There are more relaxed rules around packed lunches for trips as these happen more rarely and are seen as a treat. The guidelines for school trip packed lunches are included in trip letters. Packed lunches must never contain nut products.

Sharing Children's Learning


Bee-Bots are small, programmable robots which children use to learn early programming skills.


Children start exploring Bee-Bots in Early Years, here are some Reception children trying them out:





Children in Year 1 learnt to program the Bee-Bots to follow a planned series of simple instructions to reach their destination:





Children in Year 2 designed floor mats for the Bee-Bot robots, drawing in objects as obstacles, then programmed the Bee-Bots to move around the floor mat avoiding these. They checked whether their codes worked and read them back with their groups and then debugged them if necessary.
