

Our Federation

Activity Clubs

We have booked a number of after school activity clubs which will start in the week beginning 24th January and run for eight weeks. We will send the club list and booking information out next week. As usual, clubs will be booked on Parentmail and on a first come, first served basis, although children will only be allowed a place in one club. If there are any places left in clubs once everyone has had a chance to book then these places will be rereleased for booking. We have really struggled to find providers for some of our clubs but hope we have managed to provide a good range. Please note that all outdoor clubs will continue to take place outside even if it is cold or raining, unless the rain is so heavy that this is not appropriate, or temperatures make this unsafe, so please consider this when booking clubs and ensure children are dressed appropriately.

Interventions

Due to staff shortages across the school and with reference to current government guidance, we have taken the unfortunate decision to suspend many interventions for this half term. Many small group interventions will not be taking place for the next 6 weeks. Where possible, specialist interventions (for example Speech and Language Therapy) will be prioritised.

We would very much like to welcome all volunteer readers back to school, starting next week if possible. Please confirm that you are happy to return by speaking to the teacher you were working with or emailing the school office. We are also very happy to welcome new volunteers, please email the office if you are interested.

Tutorial Day

Tutorial Day will be taking place on Friday 11th February. School will be closed to children for the day and you will be invited to make an appointment to see your child's teacher during the day to discuss their progress, targets and wellbeing.

Covid Update

We are continuing to take reasonable precautions to limit the spread of Covid and to keep school open. We are asking staff to take regular lateral flow tests and to wear face coverings while moving around the school and children are reminded to 'catch it, bin it, kill it' and to wash their hands regularly. We will continue to inform you if there is a new Covid case in your child's class and we ask that you keep your child at home and carry out a lateral flow test if they develop Covid symptoms, including the cold-like symptoms that appear typical of the Omicron variant.

















































Well done to everyone who brought some homework in, I am looking forward to sharing more at the end of this half term!
