# News and Reminders

#### Sports Days

We have sent out information about the order of events on sports days this week. Each day events will start at 9.45am (except Nursery, please see the Nursery newsletter for details of their sports day activities). Parents and carers are welcome to arrive from 9.30am onwards and can of course arrive and leave at any time throughout the day. Access to and from the field will be via the office and the 2JW courtyard.

Children should wear P.E. kit to school, including a t-shirt in their house colour if possible (this does not need to be an official house t-shirt).

Please remember that you need to let the office know if your child usually has a school packed lunch for trips but does not need one for sports day, or if they do not usually have a school packed lunch but need one on this occasion. Please observe the packed lunch guidance of no sweets or chocolate bars, no fizzy drinks and no nut products or uncut grapes for packed lunches and picnics.

It is due to be very hot next week so please ensure your child has sun cream on and brings a hat and water bottle.

We are very grateful for our continued access to JAGS' field and ask that when children join you for their picnic at lunchtime they are reminded to continue to follow our school rules and treat their surroundings with respect, e.g. picking up their litter, not swinging on tree branches etc. We are really looking forward to seeing as many of you as possible on sports days, don't forget your running shoes!

#### Safety Outside School

In previous newsletters we have shared concerns from our neighbours about children riding their bikes and scooters too quickly down the hill towards school as this can cause collisions with people coming out of their gateways, please continue to remind your children that if they are riding on the pavement they must be aware of pedestrians.

Unfortunately this week one of our nursery children was knocked over and hurt by a cyclist on the pavement outside school. We know that it is necessary to cross part of the pavement to access the Greendale cycle path, but please could adults and older children dismount while doing this, particularly at busy times such as drop off and pick up.

Finally, please could all parents and carers who drive to pick up children park in designated parking spaces. Parking on double yellow lines, across barriers, on the pavement or in the middle of the road creates a very unsafe environment for children coming out of school.

# The Inclusion team and Supporting Transitions

At this time of the year, it is sometimes difficult for the inclusion team to meet with all parents and carers individually to discuss children. Please rest assured that if your child is already known to the team, all strategies and relevant information will be passed onto your child's new teaching team so you do not need to contact us to discuss this. However, if you have a specific concern about your child you can of course contact us to discuss this as usual.

In addition, our transition procedure is for a handover to take place in school. Your child's current teacher will meet with their new teacher and share known information and strategies in place for all children for whom reasonable adjustments have been made. Your child will also have the opportunity to spend time with their new teacher before the end of term.

Daily reading throughout the holiday is really important to enable your child to maintain their current levels.
