Latest News

Welcome back!

It has been great to welcome back all of the amazing Keyworth children and to welcome for the first time our new starters! We look forward to working with our families in providing the best possible learning experiences for your child/ren.

Collection

It was good to see many of you again in our playground when collecting your child/ren after so long. Please help us aid a smooth collection of children by not standing on pathways where other people may need to pass through.

Communication between home and school

Our main form of informing parents/carers about what is going on in school will be done via email. Please ensure that you check your emails regularly and then read any letters/newsletters that we send. Additionally, should your contact details change, please inform the school office.

You can of course ring or email the school office throughout the school day. As parents/carers are now allowed on-site at the end of the school day, this gives you an additional opportunity to speak with school staff then too.

Faunce Street entrance - closed

A reminder that children should only be using the Faunce Street school entrance if they are attending breakfast club or arrive to school late.

Breakfast and afterschool clubs

Our wraparound provision begins at 8:00am and ends at 5:55pm. Should you wish to find out more about our breakfast and afterschool clubs and/or book a place for your child/ren, please contact the school office.

Reporting a child absent

If your child is going to be absent from school on any given day, you should call the school office and provide a reason. If your child is absent on consecutive days, you still need to call the school office every day that they are absent.

School volunteers - message from Jaime

Previously, we were able to offer a few volunteer places across the school for parents/carers to help out in classes. We would like to begin this again. If you have an interest in supporting children with learning, are able to commit to a half-term or term's volunteer work (1-3 days per week), are punctual and do not mind getting stuck into school life, please send an email to office@keyworth.southwark.sch.uk requesting a volunteer placement.

We have limited spaces available so will not be able to take on everyone, however your regular help and support would be much appreciated.

Please note: If you have a child in the school, you will not be placed in their year group.

New school resources

This term, we will be relaunching our full curriculum and improving the standard of our provision. Resourcing is an important part of this so we have invested across the curriculum including buying new laptops, books for in-class and home reading, maths manipulatives and topic resources.

Reading relaunch

As I have said on numerous occasions, if there is something that parents/carers can do at home that will really help their child/ren with their learning, it is to ensure that they read every day. In the next week or so (our order has yet to arrive) your child/ren will be receiving a reading record book which needs to be signed when your child/ren have read. In school, the children will receive rewards as follows. I have asked school staff to monitor their class' home reading and to communicate with parents/carers either when reading may not be taking place or not frequently enough.

Home learning

At Keyworth, the completion of some additional learning at home is encouraged. As said above, daily reading is extremely important. Below are some additional home learning opportunities/support. Please contact your child/ren's class teacher/s for further clarification as necessary.

➤ Years 2 to 6 Maths and Spelling Rockets - The children will be given rocket cards containing all of the spelling and mental maths objectives for the year. Starting from the bottom of the rocket card, the children will be learning weekly spellings and mental maths in school and are encouraged to also practice these at home.

- ➤ Topic homework The children will be given a topic homework book with some ideas of what you can do at home as part of their topic learning. This might be creating some art or craft, eating some food from a particular country, visiting a place of interest etc.
- Mathletics, Reading Eggs, Purple Mash (whole school) and Timestable Rockstars (year 2 up). Your child/ren should have received their login details for the above online tools or within the next few days. If they have not received their logins or you have any queries, then please contact their class teacher/s.
- ➤ Letter-join Letter-join is the handwriting scheme that we use in school. We have a parent subscription where you can watch online tutorials of how letters and words are formed through the scheme, complete pre-set activities and create your own worksheets. In school, we often link our handwriting to the spellings and sounds that we are learning. If using a tablet device, children can learn to use their fingers to practise forming letters.

Breakfast bagels

Magic Breakfast are a charity aiming to end hunger as a barrier to education in UK schools. They provide the school with breakfast provisions at a reduced rate and, during lockdown, they provided breakfast directly to over 50 Keyworth families. In order for the school to support Magic Breakfast with its aim of ending hunger as a barrier to education, we will be introducing two new breakfast options starting Monday 6th September:

- ➤ Little Stars, Nursery and Reception will have a self-service breakfast station in their classrooms at the start of the school day, with options including fruit and bagels;
- For the rest of the school, there will be a bagel station in the playground between 8:45am and 9:00am. The bagels will simply be plain, toasted, buttered and cut into pieces. Should children decide that they would like something to eat, they can take a bagel and eat it before the bell goes. Any leftover bagels will be placed in the quiet area during playtime.
