
Thank you to everyone who supported Keyworth Friends' recent cake sale. £124.43 was raised which will go towards future school initiatives.

Free School Meal Holiday Vouchers

From September 2023 schools will no longer provide supermarket vouchers to pupils for HFSM. Instead Southwark Council will issue cash vouchers to the parents of all eligible pupils that can be cashed at any Post Office. In most cases, parents will receive their voucher on the first day of the holiday period.
