Attendance and referrals

As a reminder, parents/carers must contact the school every day that their child is absent from school. A reason must be provided and evidence may be requested.

The overall attendance of children to Keyworth during the first term of the academic year was extremely poor. While the school understands that there are lots of illnesses about, it is really important that all children attend school regularly. In the coming weeks, I will be reviewing attendance and making referrals to the local authority for families who are regular persistent absentees from school, with a view to prosecution.

Unauthorised term-time holidays

As I have said previously, it is against the law for families to go on unauthorised holidays during term-time. I have tried to be reasonable with this but still feel that we are not always being supported, therefore I will be reporting families who take unauthorised term-time holidays to the local authority, with a view to prosecution.

Disease management in schools

In the news, you will have seen that various illnesses are on the rise post-Covid - at Keyworth this is no different, particularly at this time of year. For clarification, I would like to make you aware of the following information:

- > Keyworth follows the advice and guidance of Public Health Southwark;
- As children get lots of different illnesses, schools are not expected to communicate this with parents/carers <u>unless</u> there is an outbreak and where cases are closely linked. Ray/Jaime will always contact Public Health Southwark for advice before taking any further action.

With all illnesses, good hygiene is important. Please encourage your child/ren to wash their hands regularly and remind them of the "catch it, bin it, kill it" message in relation to using tissues. Resources can be found using the link below:

Children's belongings



Word of the Week




