In June 2018, the Government published *Chapter 2, Childhood Obesity: A plan for action*. All schools are expected to be part of the plan in reducing obesity levels in children, hence the need for healthier lunch options and the banning of birthday treats.

For your information, Southwark has some of the highest overweight and obesity levels in the country, with 58% of adults and 43% of children in year 6 classified as obese or overweight (Southwark Healthy Weight Strategy 2016-2021). Thank you for your understanding on this matter.
