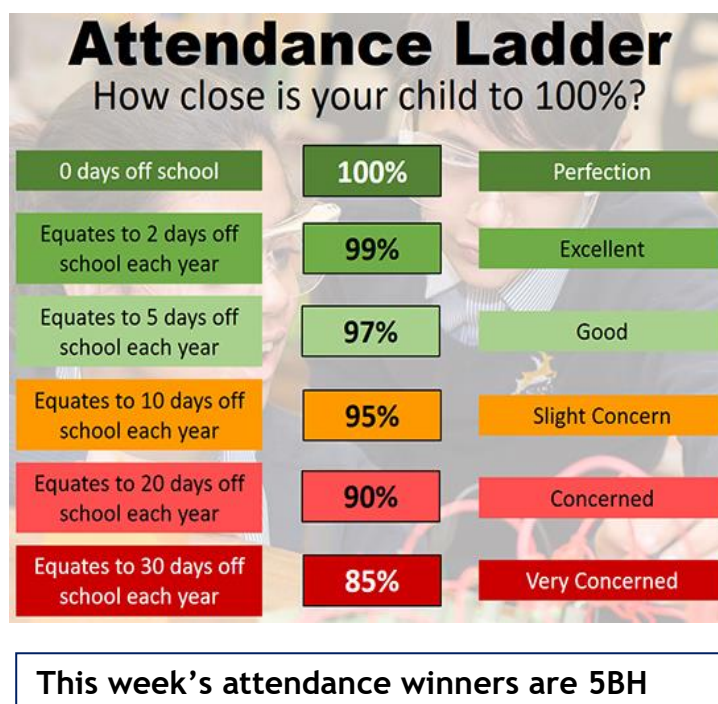

Message about free school meal holiday vouchers from Southwark Council

*"From the start of the pandemic, Southwark stepped up to fill the free school meal gap during school holidays. The council appreciates that there are huge financial challenges facing many families in the near future, with the significant increase in the cost of living in terms of food, fuel and energy bills, and that these challenges will be felt beyond those families with children in schools. The council is keen, therefore, to throw its net of support more widely than families that can be reached through schools and will be using the extension to the Household Support Fund to do just this. This means **free school meal vouchers will no longer be given to families during any school holiday** but will, instead, be targeted using much broader criteria than FSM, so that many families and households with, or without, school children will be able to benefit from additional support during this time."*

Green Fingers - The Big Grow 2022 (year 3)

Green Fingers - The Big Grow is all about teaching pupils about the seed to plate journey. Year 3 were lucky enough to be given the opportunity of taking part in two workshops, one led by Chris Collins, TV Gardener and the other by the Green Fingers chef and nutrition team.



Chef Lesson

Hosted by the Green Fingers chef and nutrition team, this 45-minute session gave our pupils the opportunity to learn about different types of vegetables that we can grow here in the UK and how to enjoy eating them. The Chef then showed the pupils how to prepare the fresh produce, turning them into a tasty salad.

Gardening Lesson

Hosted by Chris Collins, TV Gardener, this 45-minute sessions gave our children the chance to design a garden, plant their own seeds and learn about how to keep their plants alive. Chris guided the children through the activity, giving advice on the best ways to look after the seedlings.

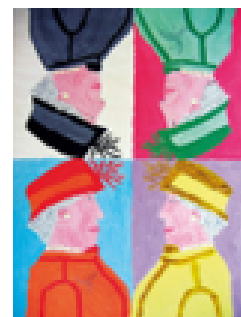
