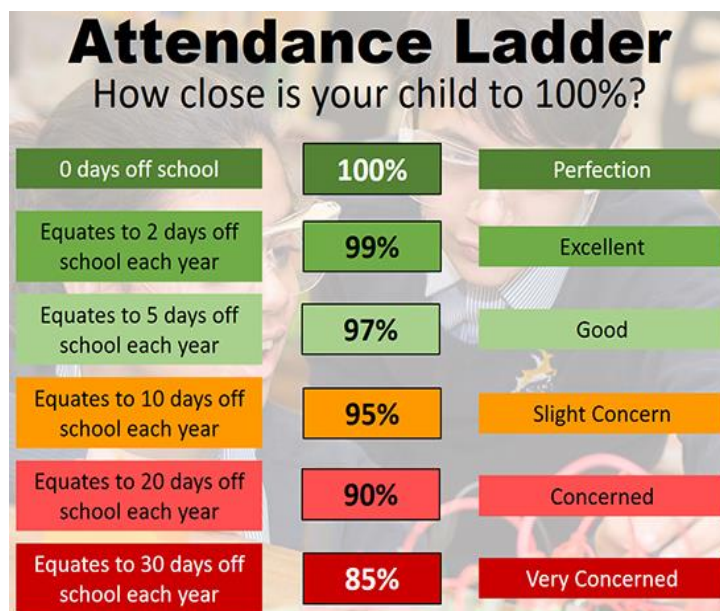

This week, year 3 went on an exciting trip to the British Museum where they mixed ancient history with a contemporary approach to historical enquiry. As an introduction to Ancient Egypt, the children explored ancient Egyptian beliefs through a huge variety of artefacts, from elaborate sarcophagi to ancient ruins covered in hieroglyphs. With the help of one of the museum's historians, the children unpicked some of the evidence they gathered using various digital resources. This was a great experience for all of the children and fantastic intro to their next topic.
