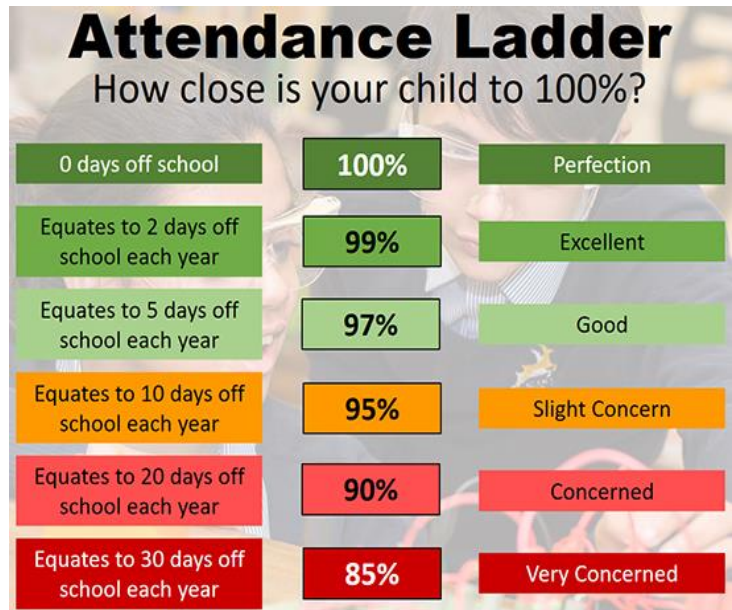

Dia de la hispanidad

El **viernes 3 de diciembre** vamos a celebrar el día de la hispanidad. En Keyworth, tenemos una gran comunidad de habla hispana proveniente de todas partes del mundo, por lo que nos gustaría celebrar esto, así como también comenzar con nuestras nuevas lecciones de español para los/as niños/as en KS2. En este día, los/as niños/as podrán venir a la escuela con ropa con los colores de la bandera de una nación de habla hispana. También realizaremos actividades con el objetivo de aprender más sobre algunos de los diferentes países de habla hispana.

Las diferentes actividades podrán incluir: investigaciones, hacer manualidades, cantar, bailar y comer comida tradicional. A la hora del almuerzo, continuaremos con la temática española con una fiesta tradicional: ¡feliz aprendizaje!

On **Friday 3rd December** we will be holding a Spanish day. At Keyworth, we have a large Spanish-speaking community from all around the world so we would like to celebrate this as well as launch our new Spanish lessons for children in KS2. On Spanish day, the children can come to school wearing clothing in the colours of the flag of a Spanish-speaking nation (look right). They will also be completing a day of activities with the aim of learning more about some of the different Spanish-speaking countries of Keyworth children. Activities might include researching, crafting, singing, dancing and eating traditional food.



At lunchtime, we will be continuing the Spanish theme with a traditional feast - *feliz aprendizaje!* (Thank you to teacher Javi for the Spanish translation!)

As we would like to prepare resources for the session, please call the school office to book onto the session and inform us of your attendance.


Children in Need
