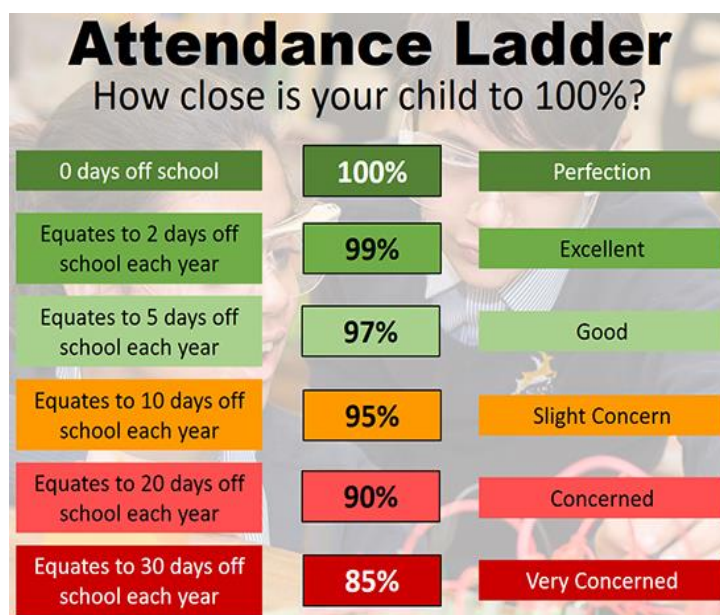

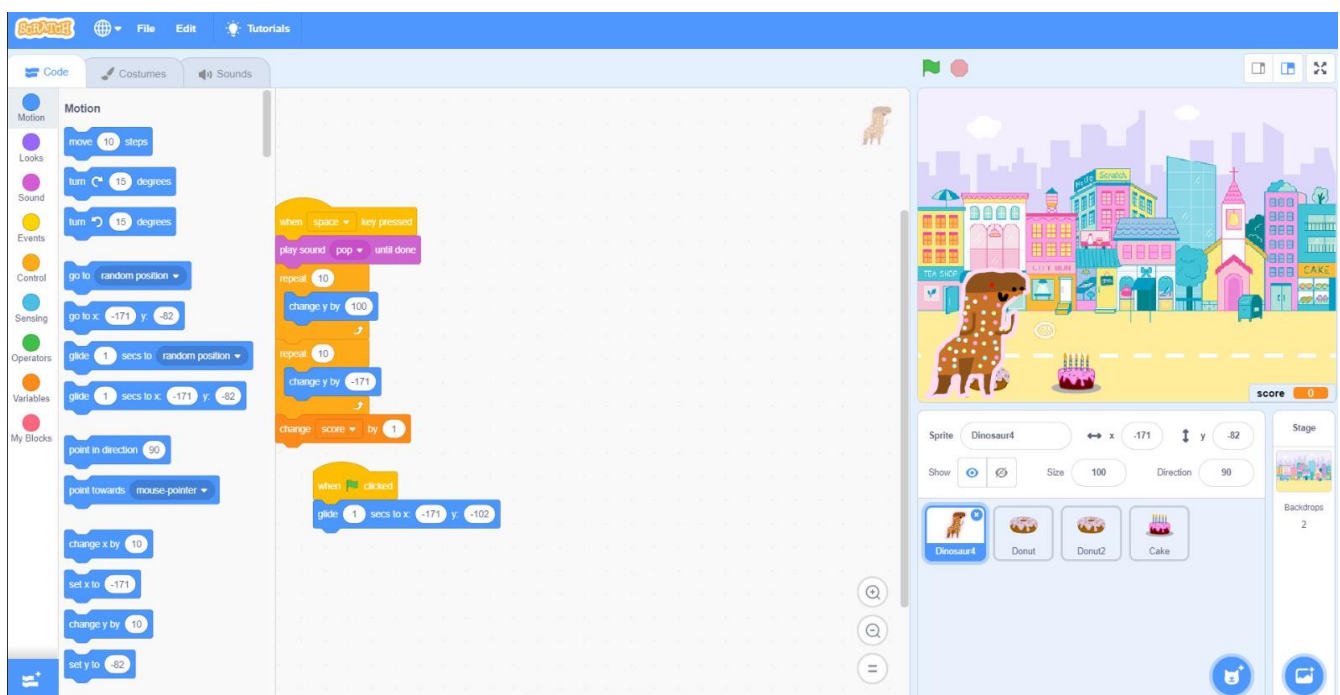
## Year 4 ukulele concert
