Things to remember...

Celebration Day

Don't forget **Thursday 17th March** is our Celebration Day in Early Years. This term the focus will be Maths. You are welcome to join us from 9.15-10.15am where we will be showing you how we teach maths. This is a chance for you to get some ideas to further support your child at home and see how it can be done in a fun and playful way.



While the weather is often wet and cold, please provide your children with a named, thick, winter coat and suitable footwear. We go to the Nature Garden three times a week and it is important that children are suitably dressed. Children have the opportunity to explore and experiment with water whilst at school. We try our best to keep your child dry by encouraging the use of aprons and rolling up of sleeves but if you know your child particularly enjoys water play, please could you provide them with a waterproof jacket / suit. If you do not have one, we are happy to provide one for you.

Please also encourage your child to practise putting on their wellies and coats independently.

Water Bottles

Please ensure your child has a named water bottle with them each day. This should only contain water, no fruit juices or squash please!

Spare Clothes

Please make sure that your child always has a spare change of clothes at school for toileting accidents and water play. If your child borrows clothes from school, please return the clothes washed and dried. If you have any socks that your child no longer needs, we would really appreciate any donations for our spare clothes box!
