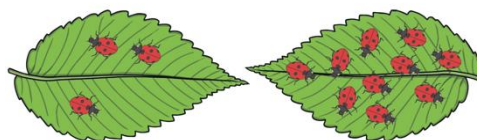
Can you bring in an object from home for our Sound Table that begins with 'y'
