Things to remember...

People Who Help Us

This term, nursery will be learning about people who help us. If any parent/carer is a dentist, doctor, vet, nurse, police officer or firefighter, please make the class teacher aware as we would love for you to come in and speak to the children about your profession and what it entails. It will also give the children the opportunity to ask questions about things they would like to know.

Sun hats and sun cream

Now that the weather is finally sunny, we recommend bringing your child to school in a named sun hat. We also recommend applying sun cream to your child before they arrive at school.

Water Bottles

Please ensure your child has a named water bottle with them each day, especially now that the weather is warming up. This should only contain water, no fruit juices or squash please!

Please make sure that your child always has a spare change of clothes at school for toileting accidents and water play. If your child borrows clothes from school, please return the clothes washed and dried.
