<u>Topic</u>

Our topic for this half term is <u>A Taste of the World</u>. We will be learning about different communities, events different people celebrate, and foods around the world. <u>Maths</u>

This term we are focusing on counting carefully, ensuring we count one number for each object, we will be practising this with a range of exciting activities counting different things! We will also be learning to count past 5 using some more counting songs, such as 1,2,3,4,5 Once I Caught A Fish Alive!

Now we have settled into our new classroom we will be focusing on building our skills in making friendships. We will also be thinking about how important it is to look after our friends, our things and our community and practicing tidying up mess around us!



Physical Development

We are still enjoying using tyres, crates and balance beams to develop our gross motor skills outside, as the leaves fall and the floor gets slippy we are progressing our spatial awareness and skills in walking carefully on different surfaces!

We still love playdough and will be exploring with this all term as well as a range of different fine motor activities and crafts by painting, printing, cutting and sticking!



Communication and Language

We will be focusing on learning new vocabulary to match our experiences this term, this will involve trying new foods and learning about different celebrations! We will encourage the children to share their thoughts and opinions.



We will have lots of practice singing songs in preparation for our end of year performance!







<u>Literacy</u>

We will enjoy lots more stories this term and continue to enjoy quality stories and nursery rhymes everyday! We are now growing our interest in reading and choosing books we know well to re-tell to our friends!

Mark making is an important introduction to forming letters and writing. We will continue to explore lots of different tools and resources to mark make and talk to an adult about the marks we have made! We are enjoying using large chalks to make large marks on the chalk-boards!

<u>Key texts</u>

Our key texts this term are 'Lima's Red Hot Chilli', 'Handa's Surprise' and 'My World, Your World'. We will enjoy listening to these lots of times, participating in repeating phrases and playing the stories in our small world and role play areas!
