#### PE

In Year 5 the children are expected to select their own reading books to take home each week. They will be given time during the week to do this and will need to bring back finished books and sign out a new one. All children need to read both independently and with an adult.

Please ensure that you sign the children's reading record when they

have read for at least 30 minutes each day. Children will collect stickers in school and will then receive certificates for every 50 independent home reads.

#### Homework

The children will be given maths and spelling homework weekly – on paper and uploaded to google classroom. A half termly topic homework has also been given out, this has a several creative activities that your child can complete at home.
