MATHS

We do not send out weekly maths homework but we encourage you to use Mathletics at home. All children should have their Mathletics login by now. Please let your child's class teacher know if you're not sure.

Practice reading and writing numbers to 10 ensuring that the numbers are written in the correct orientation. This term we are beginning with subtraction and representing this in various ways with different objects. Then we will be looking at numbers above 10 and their 'place value'. Why not do some baking at home, counting different items in the shops, how many leaves can you pick up in the park, count and take away coins sweets or toys. You could also practice writing different addition and number sentences and bring them in to show us.

Dear children and adults,

Our history/geography topic this term is 'Explorers' where we will be looking at the city we live in, our place in the UK and in the wider world. We will be learning about how to locate different countries on a map and globe and discussing the different features of a map. We are reading the books Naughty Bus by Jan and Jerry Oke and Astrogirl by Ken Wilson-Max. We will also be learning about the solar system and discussing the achievements of Mae Jemison.

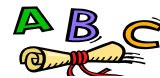
READING
