Topic

Our Topic this term is based around the Magic of Flight. We will be studying footage of human attempts of early flight and discussing the processes in which they went through for us to be able to fly in aeroplanes today. We will be doing case studies on the Wright Brothers, Bessi Coleman, Amy Johnson and Amelia Earheart and finding out how they have impacted our world today.

We will continue to look at environments and discuss natural and human made objects in the world. We will be revisiting continents, and will be looking at the countries that make up the United Kingdom, and will be exploring the oceans of our world.

Maths

In maths this term we are moving into Place Value to 50 and the composition of these numbers (how many tens and how many extra ones).

Through this, we will revisit addition and subtraction. Through our Mastery approach, we use concrete materials, part-part-whole mats, draw pictures to work out answers and explore the language around problem solving and reasoning.



We will also be continuing to discuss measurement and use non-standard units to measure objects.

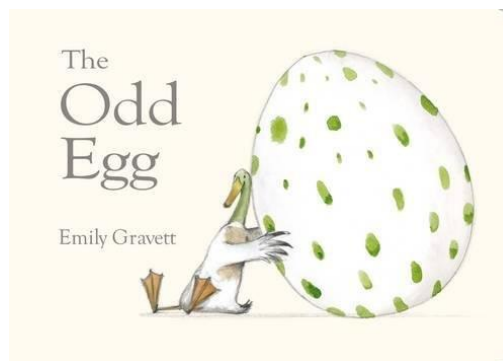
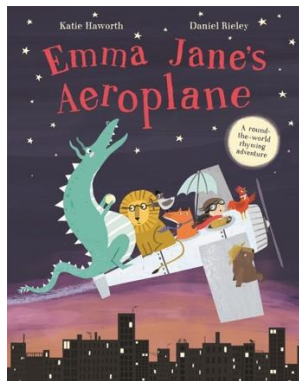
Please continue to have mathematical discussions with your children around time, weight, measurement (length and height and weight and capacity), coins, skip counting (in 2s, 5s and 10s), the composition of numbers, number bonds. Remember, Maths is EVERYWHERE and every conversation could lead to that 'light bulb' moment for your child.

English

This term we will be studying the stories Emma-Janes Aeroplane and The Odd Egg.

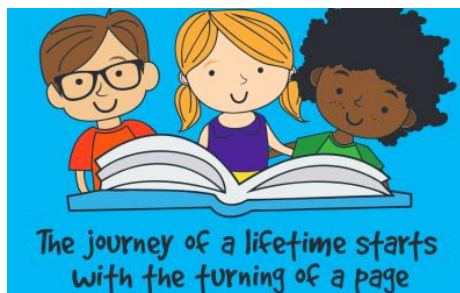
We will be writing letters, post cards, drawing story maps and rewriting familiar stories... and even tweaking them to make them our own. We will continue to talk about nouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs.

Please continue to practise the spelling of your tricky words. If you need another High Frequency Word book, please let your teacher know and we will arrange one for you.



Reading

We cannot stress enough the importance of having your child read to you daily. We are asking for a minimum of 10 minutes each day. It is noticeable when children are reading regularly at home and they are proud to share this with the class. When your child is confident with their home reader, it will be changed. It is important that you child can ask questions about the story and answer questions that adults are asking them. Your child should be able to retell the story in their own words, identify the characters, setting, problem and solution and hopefully be able to make some text-to-self connections and discuss these with the adults.



Please make sure you sign your child's reading diary every day after they read too. Children are very excited to receive their reading certificates.

Science

This term we are learning about Animals including Humans. We will recap our five senses and learn about what animals belong to each of the classification groups including, mammals, reptiles, fish, birds, amphibians and insects. We will discuss what makes each group special and how animals are classified into each of these groups. In science we will also explore warm blooded and cold-blooded animals and the habitats in which they live.

P.E

This term we move to two outdoor PE lessons. These sessions will be chilly so please send your child in warm clothes on these days e.g. jogging bottoms and a jumper.
