## Summer 2 Term - Further Information

**Reading** - Make sure child is reading for at least 10 minutes each day and that they're able to answer lots of questions about their reading book!

**Spellings** - Please ensure your child is able to spell all of their tricky words, the days of the week and the months of the year. Continue to encourage your child to sort words/pictures into different spelling groups and discuss how the same sound can be written in different ways.

**Handwriting** - Please ensure children are forming letters correctly in their letter families:

\*a, c, e, i, n, m, o, r, s, u, v, w, x, z

\*b, d, h, k, l, t

Maths - Children need to be able to quickly recall addition and subtraction facts using numbers up to 20. They need to know that subtraction is the inverse of addition (e.g. 14 + 5 = 19 and 19 - 5 = 4) and be fluent with these fact families. Please practice these at home as we will test children on these facts regularly in school.
