## Autumn 1 Term - Newsletter

Reading - Make sure your child is reading for 15 minutes each day and that they're able to answer lots of questions about their reading book! They should re-read the levelled book given to them by school 3 times to build confidence and fluency. Books must be returned to school, and new books will be given, on Mondays and Thursdays.

Maths - Remember to revise your weekly number facts to earn your reward based on your rocket card! Children will be tested each week on their number facts - they will be told which ones to learn by their teacher. Prizes will be awarded to children who are successful.

Spellings - Each week the children will take home their spellings to practice for their weekly Spelling Rockets Test on Fridays.
