

English

This half term in English, we will start by looking at the fictional story, *The Journey Home*. We will be working on using adjectives and the four different sentence types. We will continue to focus on spelling rules and ensuring we have capital letters and full stops placed correctly throughout our writing. We will begin teaching joining in handwriting for children that have secured letter formation.

Topic

Our topic this half term is Hot and Cold Places: Kenya. We will be using Geography skills to find Kenya on a map and explore some cities and other areas of the country. We will then compare Kenya with the UK.



Maths

In maths lessons, we will be focusing on number, particularly multiplication and division strategies. This will involve recalling facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times table. We will be consolidating the children's understanding of place value, the value of numbers and how to partition numbers into hundreds, tens and ones.

Science

We begin our topic of living things and their habitats this half term. We are going to look at food chains, habitats, micro habitats and animal adaptations.
