Have a go at completing one of the following tasks:

- 1. Investigate what a plant needs to survive by placing plants such as cress in different environments such as dark, cold, bright, warm and dry.
- 2. Make scientific sketches of different plants you see.

 Can you add labels to the different parts of the plant?

 Can you identify what's the same and what is different about the plants you see?

Now try some of these:

- 1. Many artists have used plants as their inspiration, from Georgia O'Keefe to Vincent Van Gogh. Can you make an artwork inspired by plants? This could be drawing or painting, it could even be from the perspective of a bee!
- 2. Select a tree, can you take a picture or sketch it once week for every week of the term? Do you notice anything happening?
