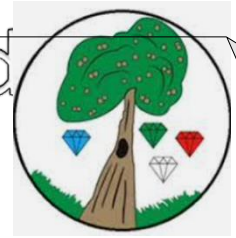


# Conservation and Our Local Area

Don't forget to log onto **Mathletics!**

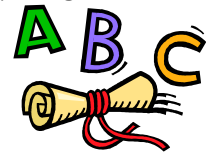
## READING

## WRITING AND TOPIC

You have a scrap book to use to complete your homework project. Over the next six weeks complete some of these activities or make some up of your own.

2. Write a **fact file** about littering and its impact on the environment.
3. Design and write a **tourist leaflet** all about your local area (Kennington, London) - describing points of interest (museums, galleries, restaurants, etc), including pictures, travel links and tips for visitors.

### NOW CHOOSE SOME OR ALL OF THESE

1. Make a piece of art, or a new useful object, using recycled objects - newspapers, plastic bottles, cardboard boxes.
2. Draw a map of your local community, including a key and symbols to represent your home, school, local clubs, etc..
3. Design a poster, encouraging other's to look after their community and stop littering.
