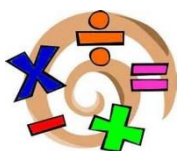


Topic - Our topic this half term is *Volcanoes and Earthquakes*. We will be learning about these extreme natural disasters experienced in different locations across the world. This topic provides some wonderful opportunities for creative, geography and science, learning amongst other subject areas.

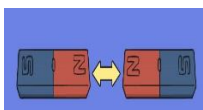


English - This term in English, we will begin by focusing on Nature Poetry. Children will be exploring a range of poetry as well as discussing and highlighting poetic features. They will also be analysing poems, expressing their views and opinions of a variety of poems and creating their very own nature poem!

To support children in their developing literacy skills, we will continue to do daily comprehension, reading and spelling activities. We are also continuing regular handwriting to encourage pride in presentation.



Maths - Our focus this term will be multiplication and division. In reasoning, we will be concentrating on using mathematical language to explain our answers. In mental maths, we will be working on our Mental Maths skills for our Maths Rockets, which will need to be practised at home.



Science - In science, we will be introducing the topic of Forces and Magnets. Children will work scientifically to carry out different tests, asking questions, recording data and explaining what they found out.
