YEAR 4 CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER SPRING 1

This newsletter will provide you with information on the half term ahead. If you have any further queries, please don't hesitate to contact us.

Topic- Our topic for this term is World War II. We will be researching and exploring what happened at this time. We will be discussing and thinking about how it would feel like to live at this time, including being evacuated.

English - This term in English, we will be developing our writing skills through looking at a variety of different texts, including a range of fiction and non-fiction. Our main text for the first few weeks will be the Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by C.S.Lewis. In spelling we will be learning suffixes, prefixes and apostrophes for contractions and we will be consolidating these through handwriting (letter join). During guided reading, we will be exploring a range of fiction and non-fiction.

Maths-We will be looking at Multiplication and Division for the first few weeks of the half term. We will then move on to Area. Your child will continue to have a rocket test each Friday. If they complete the test successfully, they will move up the rocket. They should practice the skill for the test they're on as their homework.



Science - In science we will be introducing the topic of Electricity. They will develop skills in knowledge, reasoning and classifying.

PE- Your child will have two PE sessions per week.

4MV will have P.E on Monday and Wednesdays.
