YEAR 4 CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER SPRING 2

Topic- Our topic for this term is The Vikings. We will be learning about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England. In particular, we will explore Viking customs, beliefs and invasions. We will learn about Viking laws and justices. We will compare The Vikings to other aspects of history we have studied.

English - This term in English, we will be developing our writing skills through looking at a variety of different texts, including a range of fiction and non-fiction. Our main text for the half term will be Gulliver's Travels by Jonathon Swift. In spelling, we will be continuing with the spelling rocket whilst also ensuring the children know their Year 3 and Year 4 common exceptions words (please see the end of this newsletter). We will be consolidating our spelling through handwriting (letter join). During Guided Reading, we will be exploring a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

Maths-We will be continuing with our work on Multiplication and Division for the first week after half term. We will then move on to Area and then to Fractions. Your child will continue to have a rocket test each Friday. They should practice the skill for the test they're on as their homework.



Science- In Science, we will be continuing with our topic of Electricity. The children will develop skills in knowledge, reasoning and classifying.

PE- Your child will have two PE sessions per week.

4JA will have P.E on Monday and Tuesdays.

4MV will have P.E on Monday and Wednesdays.
