READING **

Remember to read each day at home for at least 30 minutes. It is important to read a range of genres - have a look on Google Classroom for the poetry booklist for some suggestions of poems you could get from your library! This is one of the best ways to improve your vocabulary. Please record the number of home reads in your diary. Don't forget you can also use Reading Eggs.

RISING STARS WORKBOOKS



From now on, we will continue to send home weekly spellings but other homework will now be replaced by the 'Rising Stars' workbooks. These have been bought for the school for all of Year 6 and will be sent home shortly for your child to use and keep. They are free of charge. Your child will receive a Reading workbook, Spelling Punctuation & Grammar workbook and a Maths workbook. These workbooks will be pitched at the expected level for Year 6 (6ME), or at the exceeding level (6EE). We will send them home gradually over the next few weeks, starting with the Maths workbook. Your child's class teacher will explain which pages to work on each week. Please keep the books safe and remind your child to bring them back into school on the day they are required.
