History / Geography – We will be continuing our Japan topic. We will be learning about Japan's physical and human features and how they have adapted their infrastructure.

You will also have received this term's **topic homework and knowledge** organiser via email. Additionally, these will be shared on your child's Google Classroom page. If you would like a paper version, your child can ask their class teacher.

English - This half term, our class texts will be: The Sleeper and the Spindle and Grimm's Tales. Through these texts, we will be focusing on writing descriptive pieces as well as various narratives.

Reading – One of the most effective ways you can support your child with their academic progress and development, is through reading together regularly. Your child will receive a book from school which they should look after, and bring into school each day.

Children should be reading at home each day, preferably with an adult, for 20 minutes. Please sign your child's reading record each day to show they are reading regularly and so they can earn rewards in school. Please note, there is a £5 charge for lost books.

Maths - This half term we will be working on shape, area and perimeter. You can support your child at home by continuing to complete the weekly SATS practise homework. Remember, our maths scheme 'White Rose' has a parent area where your child can consolidate any learning in class. There are videos for each lesson taught. <u>Science</u> – Our final science topic is Evolution and Inheritance. We will be learning about fossils and how they provide information about living things millions of years ago and how animals are adapted to suit their environments and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

R.E – This half term, we will learning about the similarities and differences that world religions share.

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P.E – This term we will be playing rounders.
