Topic

Our topic next half term is the Great Fire of London. We will be looking at the history of the Great Fire of London and learning about fire safety.

English

At the start of the next half-term, English lessons will focus on speaking, reading and writing about the Great Fire of London. As we progress through to Christmas, we will be looking at 'The Bear and the Piano' by David Litchfield and exploring poetry through the text 'If All the World Were...' by Joseph Coelho.



Maths

Next half term, we will be learning about addition and subtraction. For this unit, we will build on the foundations of place value from autumn 1. By the end of the term we will be looking at adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers. Please continue to support your child at home by helping them to understand the tens and ones in 2 digit numbers by asking questions such as how many tens in 36?

Science

We will be looking at 'Animals, including Humans' this half term. We will be focusing on how to keep ourselves healthy, the importance of exercise, eating the right kinds of foods, and hygiene.
