Tepic - Our topic this half term is <u>Ancient Egypt</u>! We will be having a history focus and looking at the impact Ancient Egypt had on the world. We will look at where Ancient Egypt was located, their culture, religion, architecture and the legacy they have left behind.

English - This half term, we will start by reading *Black Dog* by Levi Pinfold, we will focus on creating suspense and tension in our narrative work. We will then study *The Pied Piper of Hamelin*, where children will be exposed to the genre of myths and legends.

<u>Maths</u> - This half term, we will be continuing our work on multiplication and division, before moving on to study length and perimeter. Homework will be set on Google Classroom on Fridays and will support the facts needed for the rocket tests.

<u>\$cience</u> - This half term, we will be learning about Light, different light sources, reflection and conducting experiments.

R.E – In R.E we will be asking, what can we learn about special symbols and signs used in religions? Christianity, Islam and world views.

<u>Homework –</u> This year we will be putting the homework on Google Classroom. Each week there will be a maths homework which will be linked to times tables or the rocket card steps which may be an interactive activity or questions to answer.
