Topic - Our topic this half term is Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. We will be learning about invasion and settlement as well as gods, warriors and every-day life. We will be doing some Viking artwork and some DT. Please see the homework sheet that was sent out before half term.

English - This half term, we will begin by reading Beowulf with a focus on writing our own playscripts as well as getting into character to do some descriptive writing. We will also be writing poetry about Viking longboats.
